### Attend both days or just one day

**Day One**

#### **Saturday, October 10, 2009 —10:00 am - 4:30 pm**

Introduction to natural trimming guidelines, lecture and discussion. This will be followed by a demonstration of the abrasive trim method using an angle grinder with a sanding disk. The demonstration will show how much easier, faster and accurate this method is over using traditional tools.

**Day Two**

#### **Sunday, October 11, 2009 —9:00 am - 5:30 pm**

Participants will, in turn, trim their own horse (recommended or a borrowed one) under close supervision. Phil will start the trim while explaining the needs of that particular hoof. The next two hoofs will be a joint effort with, Phil trimming 1/2, and the participant the other. This will provide an easy guideline for the person new to trimming. The last hoof will be done by the participant but with guidance from the instructor.
